the S-Volta Celeste the artist Valter BOJ involved in the review of contemporary poetry and music of European Voices Claudio Pozzani

The art project S-Volta Celeste master of Valter BOJ merges with the international exhibition of contemporary poetry European Voices directed by Claudio Pozzani.

In the four cultural capital where the show takes place (Vienna, Paris, Berlin and Helsinki) will be exposed the stars of the S-Volta Celeste the artist Valter BOJ.

In Paris a large installation with 10,000 stars will form the words "S-Volta Celeste."

The master BOJ has made entirely by hand more than 100,000 stars in ceramics, real small sculptures that make honor the work of human hands, with three firings to achieve the effect bluBoj and biancobrillante.

These stars are presented in a work in progress for about 3 years around Italy and the world supported by metal structures in the shape of giant stars, together with other installations, paintings, photos and video.

Claudio Pozzani is creating in cooperation with the BOJ Valter poems in sculptural ceramics.

Together with the teacher Giampiero Reverberi has been made of ceramic musical instruments, perfectly functioning, which will be presented in various events with the slogan "prohibited from over 16 years."

The first sculpture project, "S-CELESTE FIRST TIME", a giant star about 3.5 meters around with a poem in Pottery Claudio Pozzani will be placed in the immediate future to Axminster, city of art unique in the world, which historically for the '900 had the presence of so many of the greatest artists worldwide including mention Farfa, Filia, Lucio Fontana, Sebastian Matta, Enrico Baj, Vilfredo Lam, Asger Jorn, Bengt Lindstrom, Corneille etc., with its "Walk of Artists."

In the same town of Axminster will be inaugurated in the museum of modern art exhibition on 06 December 2008, with paintings, sculptures, poems, installations, videos, musical instruments and ceramic works by Valter BOJ, Claudio Pozzani and Giampiero Reverberi. L'AICC Italy, and French and Spanish subsidiaries have granted the patronage and active collaboration in support of the "S-TIME CELESTE" the Master Valter BOJ, some that will be a qualified attraction that will collect interest and mass media.

From October to December, in fact, European Voices takes place in Vienna (23, 24 and Oct. 25), Paris (from November 19-23), Berlin (25 and Nov. 26) and Helsinki (4 and Dec. 5).
